Two Sexual Assaults
College Station, Texas

The College Station Police Department reports two separate sexual assaults.

The first sexual assault occurred at approximately 6:24 p.m., March 27, 2008, within the city of College Station. The victim has chosen to participate in the pseudonym program.

The second sexual assault occurred on March 28, 2008. Officers from the College Station Police Department responded to the College Station Medical Center. Upon arrival, it was determined that the victim was sexually assaulted while attending a party in College Station. The victim has decided to take part in the pseudonym program.

Due to the investigative nature of these two cases, no further information can be released.

Both investigations are being conducted by the College Station Police Department's Criminal Investigations Division.
