Two Sexual Assaults College Station, Texas

In press releases, the College Station Police Department reports two separate sexual assaults.

On April 7, 2008, at approximately 3:04 p.m., a sexual assault was reported to the College Station Police Department. The assault was reported to have occurred by a person known to the victim. The victim has chosen to participate in the pseudonym program.

On April 7, 2008, at approximately 4:35 p.m., a second sexual assault was reported to the College Station Police Department. The assault was reported to have occurred in the 1300 block of Southwest Parkway at approximately 11:00 p.m., Sunday, April 6, 2008. The victim has chosen to participate in the pseudonym program. The victim was abducted by two black males and an unknown third suspect driving a dark colored van. The victim did not know the assailants.

Suspect One:

Black male
5'07" to 5'09" in height
150 to 160 pounds in weight
25 to 32 years of age
Unshaven

Suspect Two:

Black male
5'08" to 5'10" in height
150 to 160 pounds in weight
25 to 32 years of age
Clean shaven

Both cases are being investigated by the College Station Police Department's Criminal Investigations Division. Due to the investigative nature of these two cases, no further information can be released.
