In a news release, the College Station Police Department reports a criminal attempt of a sexual assault.

Criminal Attempt Sexual Assault
100 block of Church Avenue
College Station, Texas

At approximately 02:12 a.m., Wednesday, April 30, 2008, officers from the College Station Police Department were dispatched to the 100 block of Church Avenue for a report of a possible sexual assault. This location is in the vicinity of Wellborn Road and University Drive. The victim reported that she was physically assaulted by an unknown suspect while in a parking lot. The suspect committed actions that led the victim to believe that he was attempting a sexually assault. Other individuals in the area contacted the police.

The victim has elected to participate in the Pseudonym Program. No further information can be released at this time. This investigation has been turned over to the Criminal Investigations Division of the College Station Police Department.
