

## Timely Warning

An aggravated robbery was reported to the City of Bryan Police Department.

Aggravated Robbery  
4200 block of Boyett Street

At approximately 9:25 p.m., Wednesday, July 9, 2008, officers from the City of Bryan Police Department responded to a report of an aggravated robbery in the 4200 block of Boyett Street. This location is parallel to Wellborn Road in the Northgate district.

The victim reported that he was walking home from Texas A&M University when someone tapped him on the shoulder. An unknown person stated, "Give me all your money." A second unknown person approached the victim. A black handgun was pointed at the victim by one of the suspects. The victim gave the suspects the cash from his wallet. The two suspects took the cash and left the area on foot. The victim walked home and called the Bryan Police Department. The victim was not physically injured or harmed.
