

Timely Warning

Campus crime alerts and timely warnings to the community comply with the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (Clery Act).

An attempted sexual assault was reported to the City of College Station Police Department.

On Friday, July 25, 2008, at approximately 01:55 a.m., officers from the College Station Police Department responded to the area of 300 Tauber Street in reference to an attempted sexual assault. The victim stated that she had walked to her car from the Northgate area. She was sitting inside her vehicle talking on her cell phone. At this time, she noticed the suspect approaching from the back of her car. The suspect had his pants opened and his genitalia was exposed. The suspect opened the driver's car door and placed his hand over the victim's mouth and attempted to pull her from the vehicle. The victim managed to move his hand and began to scream. The suspect then fled the scene on foot. Police Officers checked the area, but were unable to locate the suspect.
