

Timely Warning

Campus crime alerts and timely warnings to the community comply with the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (Clery Act).

An aggravated assault was reported to the City of College Station Police Department.

On Tuesday, October 7, 2008, at approximately 9:30 p.m., officers with the College Station Police Department responded to the area of George Bush Drive and Montclair Avenue for an aggravated assault. Responding officers discovered that the victim had been assaulted near the intersection of Montclair Avenue and Kerry Street. The victim was walking south when he was approached by two unknown suspects. One suspect displayed a knife while the second suspect struck the victim in the face with a closed fist. The victim fled the area and contacted the police. The victim sustained minor injuries during the assault. Officers searched the area, but were unable to locate the suspects in this case.

Suspects' Description:

Both suspects are described as black males; wearing dark colored shirts and shorts; approximately six feet in height; thin body build; and in their late teens or early twenties of age.
