

## ***Timely Warning***

Campus crime alerts and timely warnings to the community comply with the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (Clery Act).

The City of Bryan Police Department is investigating a robbery that occurred at the office of the Texas A&M Employee Assistance Program.

On Wednesday, August 5, 2009, at approximately 07:54 a.m., officers with the City of Bryan Police Department responded to the 3600 block of East 29<sup>th</sup> street at the office of Texas A&M Employee Assistance Program. Responding officers discovered that an A&M staff member (victim) was assaulted by a suspect who had entered the office on the premise of asking for information. Prior to leaving, the suspect took property belonging to the victim. The victim sustained minor injuries. Officers with the Bryan Police Department are currently looking for the suspect.
