On September 21, 2009 at about 10:22 pm., College Station Police Officers responded to a reported robbery in the 500 block of Cherry St. The victim, identified as a 22 year old male, stated that he was walking in the area when he was accosted by 2 black males that pulled up next to him in a car. The victim said one of the men jumped out of the car and demanded his belongings. The actor pushed the victim to the ground and forcefully took his phone and attempted to steal his backpack. The actor gave up on his

attempt to take the backpack and fled in the car towards Bryan. The victim suffered minor abrasions in the scuffle; he did not require medical attention.
